draft language input for the regulation draft.

ADDITION OF PRELIMINARY BREATH ALCOHOL SCREENING DEVICES (Discussion/For Possible Action) The COTI members will discuss three breath alcohol testing devices, the LT7 and LX9, both manufactured by LifeLoc, and the Intoxilyzer 800, manufactured by CMI, and whether to add these devices to Nevada's list of approved devices for use as preliminary breath alcohol screening instruments. Possible action may include a decision to approve any or all of these devices, decline to approve any or all of these devices, or to table the discussion for a later date.
