DISCUSION OF THE COTI'S ROLE IN ANSI/ASB STANDARDS FOR TESTING AND CALIBRATION OF EVIDENIAL BREATH INSTRUMENTS (Discussion Only/Non-Action Item) The COTI members will discuss the ANSI/ASB standards generally and how such standards are being used in Nevada and other states. The COTI members will specifically address the difference between evidentiary testing standards and instrument calibration standards and the role of the COTI and Nevada forensic testing laboratories in implementing those standards. The COTI

members will solicit input from Forensic Analysts of Alcohol attending the meeting on their perspectives. No vote or action will be taken based on this discussion.

- 6. DISCUSSION OF NATIONAL STANDARDS FOR REPORTING OF EVIDENTIARY BREATH TESTING (Discussion/Possible Action Item) The COTI members will discuss the anticipated ANSI/ASB standard for reporting of evidential breath testing results. The anticipated standard, which is not yet approved by ANSI/ASB, includes a change from reporting two results to one result for an evidentiary breath test. Input will be solicited from attending non-member Forensic Analysts of Alcohol. Possible action may include approval of adopting the new standard, rejecting the new standard, or continuing the discussion until a later date.
- 7. PUBLIC COMMENT (Non-Action Item) No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on an agenda as an item upon which action may be taken.
